
2017 SOGI Youth Survey Highlights

Survey questions asked about community climate, knowledge of resources, and supports that may help young adults meet their goals.


SURVEY SAMPLE

115 youth age 14-26 completed the survey.



COMMUNITY CLIMATE

Research has consistently found that supportive, affirming communities mediate many risk factors that LGBTQ+ youth experience. Although youth responding to the survey reported progress toward acceptance in the community, victimization was a common experience and many LGBTQ+ youth felt the need to hide their identity.



In the last year, due to fear of negative consequences...



72% of LGBTQ+ youth concealed their sexual orientation or gender identity



34% of LGBTQ+ youth avoided situations, activities, or people for fear of being labeled as LGBTQ+




44% of LGBTQ+ youth concealed their support of LGBTQ+ issues



9% of straight/ cisgender allies concealed their support of LGBTQ+ issues




